

Physiology of the Grid

- Latest draft: v2.9 (6/22/2002)
 - Second public draft
- Minor updates since original GGF4 draft
 - Track GS Spec changes
- Also appearing in:
 - IEEE Computer (June)
 - > Reduced version of Physiology paper
 - Book edited by Tony Hey (Fall 2002)

Grid Service Specification

- Latest draft: v3, 7/17/2002
- Major revisions since first draft at GGF4
 - Overall model has not changed
 - But lots of details have changes
 - > Service data
 - > Notification
 - > Handles and resolver
 - > Removed primary key, compatibility assertion
 - > Based on new WSDL v1.2 draft
 - serviceType (extended for inheritance)
 - Open content model

A Timestamp for Distributed Computing

- Specification for measured timestamps
 - dateTime + accuracy + resolution
- Previously an inactive document from GMA working group (performance area)
 - Same approach
 - Significantly revised, particularly by reorienting toward XML
 - Dan Gunter, Brian Tierney + Steve Tuecke
- Should this be an ogsi-wg document?
 - Propose yes

Grid Compliance Service

- Requirements, Design, and Specification documents
 - "A Grid Compliance Service is a testing service which tests other Grid services for their compliance with the Grid Service Specification and their own service specification."
- Should these be ogsi-wg document?
 - Propose yes

Java OGSI Hosting Environment

- Specification of Java interfaces that define a portable container for implementing Grid services
- Introduced on 7/19/2002
- Should this be an ogsi-wg document?
 - GGF4 ogsi-wg roadmap included this
 - Propose no
 - Instead form Java OGSI/A working group
 - > Separate working group to focus on Java implementation aspects of OGSI/A
 - > Will discuss at OGSA Roadmap BOF (Tuesday 6pm)

OGSA Security Document

- "Open Grid Services Security Architecture"
- "OGSI Security Roadmap GGF Specification Roadmap towards a Secure OGSA"
- Introduced on 7/19/2002
- Should this be an ogsi-wg document?
 - Propose no
 - Instead form OGSA Security
 - > Will discuss at OGSA Roadmap BOF (Tuesday 6pm)

Other Documents

- "Grid Service Primer"
 - Physiology paper has some of this, but is not detailed enough to really understand the GS Spec
 - Need a document that includes motivations, explanation of approaches and decisions.

W3C WSDL WG

- W3C started a WSDL working group
 - Drafting v1.2 to become W3C recommendation
- Steve Graham (IBM) & Steve Tuecke are invited experts on this wg, representing GGF
 - Inject OGSI requirements into WSDL wg
 - Email list, weekly phone calls, face-to-faces
- WSDL v1.2 draft (release July 2002) contains two features that are critical to OGSI
 - serviceType (still working on inheritance)
 - Open content model

IBM/Microsoft WS Security Architecture

- In April, IBM & Microsoft released:
 - Web service security architecture
 - WS-Security specification: SOAP message integrity, confidentiality, credential passing
 - > Submitted to OASIS in July
- OGSA Security Roadmap based on this

 - > WS-Security, SAML, XACML, XrML
